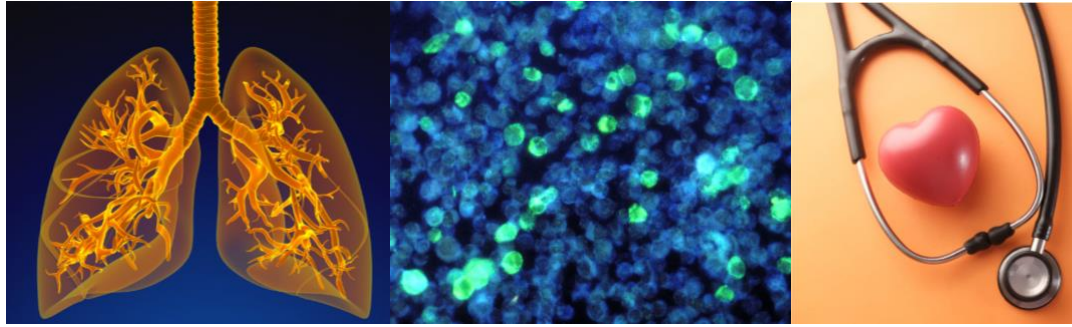


STUDY INVITE

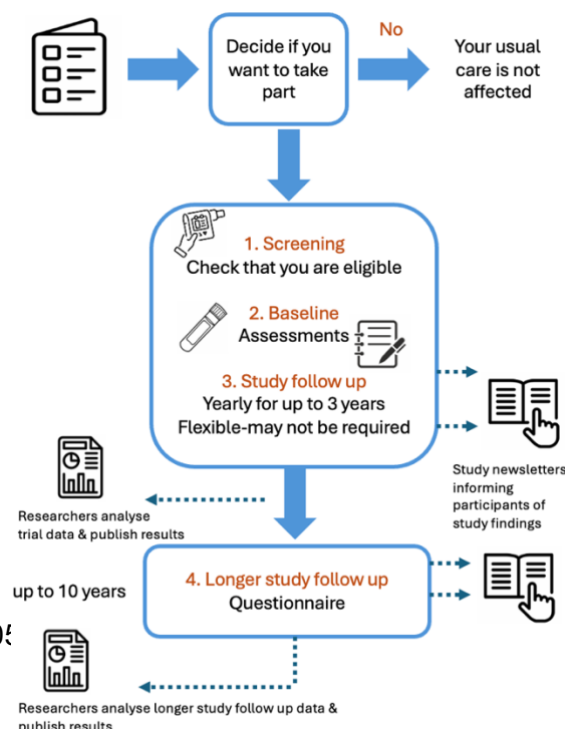
You are invited to join a clinical research study about lung health. We are inviting volunteers to take part in a monitoring study that observes lung health over time. **This is important to help better lung health for all.**

We are seeking to recruit volunteer participants who are smokers, non-smokers and people with COPD. We are hoping to recruit 280 participants. The study is open at the Cambridge Biomedical Campus.

- The study is called SCOPE-COPD which stands for: *Systematic characterisation of pre-chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) & COPD Observational Cohort Study*.
- The first part of the study is to sign up for a screening visit to see if you are eligible to take part. This involves an assessment of your lung function and a blood test.
- If you are eligible to proceed into the study, you will have comprehensive and detailed research assessments. This may include further lung function tests to see how well your lungs work, and CT scans of your lungs. In a select, smaller group of individuals who are eligible and consent to these, optional assessments may include a bronchoscopy (camera test of the lungs).
- Participants will then be in flexible follow up in the study. You may have repeat lung function tests; yearly for up to 3 years. You will also have repeat CT scans at about 2 years into the study.
- **You will be compensated for participation, plus travel expenses.**
- It is an observational study, no trial of medicines are involved.
- Your data will be kept secure and you will not be identifiable from any results of the study. You will receive a newsletter telling you about the results and information gained from the study if you would like to receive this.
- Thank you for your potential interest in the study. We hope that if you do take part you find participating in the study an interesting and worthwhile experience.



- Dr Marie Fisk and Dr Martin Knolle are the lead researchers for the study. They are respiratory consultants at Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.
- The Sponsor of the study is Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.
- The study is a collaboration between Cambridge University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust with the University of Cambridge and GSK. GSK will be providing scientific input as well as funding the work. GSK is a research partner in this study and will provide support and expertise in sample analysis and analysis of de-identified data but will not have access to any patient identifiable information.
